## What are the benefits of membership?

As a shareholding member of Glen Oaks, you will:

- be eligible to vote in the Board elections
- be able to stand for election to the Board yourself
- receive the Annual Report and Annual Financial Statements
- appoint the Association's Auditors
- be involved in approving changes to our Rules (as required)

## Can I become a member?
